YOLB is a year-long program that deepens organizers understanding of issues impacting their community, around race, class, & gender. You will learn about the roots causes of issues, so that you can take action in your community, and make your voice heard. As you gain hands on experience and knowledge, you will also learn about & develop your own leadership skills & teamwork.

additional days as needed

KJP is for youth organizers to do the lead thinking and planning for KGA's campaigns. You will develop campaign strategy & tactics, communicate & represent KGA's campaigns & work in external spaces, workshop & trainings—this includes Club officers, SSC reps, etc. You will take your leadership to the next level as you build our base and run our campaigns!
